

Recycle Cell Phones – Help Domestic Violence Victims

One easy way you can help victims of domestic violence is to donate your old cell phone. Cell phones are reprogrammed and used as 911 Emergency phones for individuals in the community at risk of domestic violence. This communication may provide a critical link between law enforcement and a victim of domestic violence who is in a life threatening emergency.

What You Need to Do

Before donating your cell phone, erase any stored information, including your contact list, text messages, and listings of incoming/outgoing numbers. Most cell phones use a "master reset" to delete information quickly and easily. Also, verify that your account has been cancelled with your service provider.
